Remote Desktop Connection to PCLab

Windows 10

The Windows 10 operating system comes with a remote desktop client already installed so you don't need to install additional software. To launch the application, type "remote desktop" in the search box on the taskbar and then select Remote Desktop Connection. This selection will open the remote desktop connection dialog box.

Mac

Get Microsoft Remote Desktop 10 from the App Store and follow the installation instructions

Ubuntu Linux

The Ubuntu operating system also comes with its own native remote desktop client. To launch the application, type "remote desktop" in the search box on the dock and then select Remmina Remote Desktop Client. If you can't find the application, follow ? these instructions to do the installation.
