## Important: Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) Requirement for myVPN

As part of our ongoing commitment to keeping your data secure, we're making an important update to the myVPN service.

**Starting July 22, 2024**, UBC's myVPN service will require multi-factor authentication (MFA) for an additional layer of security. This applies to all UBC students, faculty, and staff at the Vancouver and Okanagan campuses.

## What to expect:

• When connecting to myVPN after July 22, add "@" to your username followed by your preferred authentication method (e.g. for the Duo app you would type username@app).

- You will receive a prompt on your chosen device for verification.
- Subsequent connections will recall your information for a seamless experience.
